What We Do



Life Teen is a comprehensive youth ministry program with a strong focus on the Eucharist. Starting with a **Teen Mass**, high school teens are placed in an environment where they have the opportunity to enter into a relationship with God through Jesus Christ and His Church. Immediately following Mass, teens gather at "**Life Night**" to learn about the Church and their faith in challenging ways. Some, for the first time, find themselves becoming a part of a community where they feel loved and accepted.

"**Service First Sundays**," taking place every 1st Sunday of the Month, are opportunities for our parish youth to engage in service projects amidst the faith and fellowship of their MQP community.

Adults of all ages are invited to support our youth programs. Teens need people of all ages to walk with them on their faith journey.

Life Teen Core Team

Opportunity for adults of all ages to devote their time and energy by being present to the needs of teens in a loving and giving way. Responsibilities include planning and implementing Life Nights, small group facilitation, spending time with teens at other youth ministry events and monthly planning meetings. Training provided.

Life Teen Support Teams

Opportunity for parents of teens and others to devote time and energy to the ministries that support Life Teen. These include

hospitality ministry (feeding teens), environment support (set up and clean up for Life Nights), chaperones and drivers to Service First Sunday projects, social events and archdiocesan events, publicity and administrative support, and liturgical involvement for the Teen Masses.

Confirmation Catechists

Help prepare high school teens for the Sacrament of Confirmation. Team members are responsible for facilitating small group gatherings, attending the Confirmation Retreat, and work with the Confirmation service projects. Training provided.



To Volunteer:

- Have a desire to bring our teens closer to Christ.
- Interview with the Youth Minister, undergo a Background check, and attend the Called To Protect/Safe Environment class through the Archdiocese.
- Alert the youth minister at least one week prior of an absence
- Be flexible and have a sense of humor.
