Skyline Student Parking Policy
July 1, 2010

Mary, Queen of Peace Parish (MQP) parking lot usage during the week is prioritized for those that attend: 1) Parish Liturgies including daily Mass, Holy Days, Weddings and Funerals; 2) Parish programs; 3) Local community non-profit organizations that use the parish facility for a program; 4) Local community events held nearby the parish and 5) other special requests.

Using the above guidelines, after allowing for the parking needs for our parish and local community programs, there are a limited number of parking spots available for Skyline student parking. This limited number of parking spaces will be offered to those students that are in greatest need of parking, that by not being able to drive to school it presents an extreme hardship for their parent(s)/legal guardian(s). MQP follows Skyline student parking policy of allowing only seniors and juniors to park in the lot. All requests for student parking will be considered based on need, parish membership, and are approved by the parish administrator.

Students are expected to comply with the following parking lot rules. If a violation of these rules occurs, depending on its severity, the student will be given one warning and if the violation occurs a second time the student will surrender their parking permit and no longer be permitted to park in the parish parking lot.

1. A parking lot agreement which indemnifies and holds harmless the parish and Catholic Archdiocese of Seattle from any and all loss, cost, damage or expense related to parking in the lot must be signed by the student, their parent/guardian and the parish administrator.
2. A copy of the student's driver's license, vehicle registration and evidence of insurance coverage must be on file with parking lot agreement.
3. A digital picture of the student with their vehicle (with license plate visible) must be provided to the parish office to make a parking pass. Please email to office@mqp.org
4. Students may only park for their approved reasons and on designated days.
5. Vehicle speed in the parking lot should be no more than 5 to 10 mph.
6. Vehicle must be parked in the south parking lots near the yellow planting strip that divides the upper and lower parking lots.
7. MQP Parking Permit must be displayed face-up on dashboard, and visible from the outside of the vehicle.
8. When leaving or returning to the parking lot, the driver and all passengers must walk within the parking lot islands and then walk only in the gravel walkway in the center island, then use the crosswalks and light to cross 228th Avenue.
9. No garbage should be disposed of in the lot.
10. In the event of a large parish liturgy (funeral or holy day) the student will not be permitted to park in the lot that day.
11. Student will participate in parish grounds beautification days or perform another community service for the parish for each semester parked at MQP.
12. A donation to help offset the parish costs related to student parking.
